A Level & Technical Exam Results 2019

Students at Sir Thomas Fremantle School are celebrating after receiving the school's first ever set of A-Level results. The majority of students achieved above the national average in a range of subjects and achieved their first choice of university place. Students of Biology, Chemistry and Physics achieved particularly highly and other areas of success include Geography, Law, History and Media Studies.

The majority of students made good progress against their starting points. In particular, stand-out performances came from Thomas Humphreys who achieved an A in History and Maths, as well as a B in Geography. Amal Raja achieved three B grades including Chemistry and Biology, and Naraa Motohashi achieved an A* within her solid set of results.

STFS has now allowed students to progress to universities including Exeter, Sussex, Newcastle and Keele. We have students who have secured engineering apprenticeships, as well as secure and settled employment.

We are very proud of what our students have achieved in this first ever set of A-level results at Sir Thomas Fremantle School. They have set an impressive benchmark for our future students and demonstrate the school's ongoing commitment to an inclusive environment that recognises the capacity of all students and celebrates their achievements in all areas.
