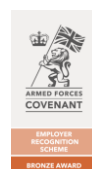
Dear Parents/Carers

As we approach the last full academic term before the GCSE exams begin, I am sure you are as eager as we are for our Year 11 students to begin their formal revision and make the most of their time.

There are English revision sessions Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, and I have indicated below which topic will be covered in each English session. Your son/daughter can decide if this is an area they need support in, or if they feel confident. Their class teacher may also direct them to particular sessions based on recent Mock and in- class assessment data. In this way all of the Language and Literature components will be re-visited both in and out of lessons.

In addition to these after school revision sessions, we have planned two extra-curricular opportunities for Year 11s studying GCSE Literature: an external study day on *An Inspector Calls*, hosted by Sovereign Education in Birmingham, and an in-school performance of *Jekyll and Hyde*, performed by Red Hearth Theatre. These two events are suitable for all students taking the Literature exam but do carry an additional financial contribution. Further details will be sent separately.
