## Re: Exam texts for GCSE English Literature

At the start of Year 10, I sent information home about purchasing several texts that will be required for the GCSE English Literature exam: *An Inspector Calls* and *Julius Caesar*. There is a third text that is required for students to study, and we highly recommend that they have their own copy to annotate and revise from. This is *Jekyll and Hyde*, by Robert Louis Stevenson. We recommend the Wordsworth Classic edition, currently available on Amazon for under £3. The ISBN is: 9781853260612, but any edition of the novel is acceptable, and there are free versions available online as well (I have included several links below).

In normal circumstances, we would be starting *An Inspector Calls* this term, and reading *Jekyll and Hyde* in the Autumn term, but due to the unexpected circumstances we find ourselves in, the decision has been made to move this drama text to later in the GCSE course, and to begin reading the novel *Jekyll and Hyde* this term.

English teachers will be setting relevant tasks connected to the reading of the novel starting in early May, and if you have any difficulty obtaining a physical copy, please do contact your child's English teacher directly. It is also fine for the initial study of the novel to read an electronic version instead.
