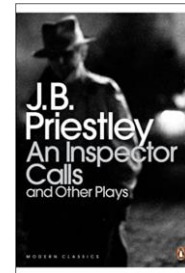

Re: GCSE English Literature Study in September

In September, our KS4 students will begin their study of the set GCSE text *An Inspector Calls*. As we encourage our GCSE students to annotate and mark their texts, it is necessary for them to buy their own copies of the texts. I recommend the Penguin Modern Classic version. The details are:

The present guidelines means that the students will need to leave their texts at school in their lockers. If your child is in Year 10 in September, they will be issued with an exercise book that they will leave in their English classroom. If they are going into Year 11, they will be able to continue to use their folders but they will need to stay at school.
