re: Year 12 Parents Evening – Thursday 17th June, 4.30 – 7.00pm

Just a reminder about our forthcoming Year 12 parents evening: this has been a challenging year but students have risen to its challenges magnificently. We would strongly advise all parents/carers to attend so that we can discuss your child's progress and identify how best to support them as they move towards the final phase of their Sixth Form studies. All students are expected to attend alongside their parents so they can take part in the discussion.

Owing to the current restrictions imposed by COVID-19 we are having to limit visitor numbers on site and will host the evening virtually. This will take the form of video calls with subject teachers at pre-agreed times, hosted on Microsoft Teams. We have allocated a maximum of 10 minutes to each appointment for each subject and would ask for your co-operation in keeping to the arranged times so that everybody has a fair and equal opportunity. If you feel that a longer, more detailed discussion is required on any point, you may wish to arrange a separate meeting with your child's teacher: please do this direct with him or her.

I have attached an online guide to help with logging in for your Teams meetings with your child's teachers: it is better to use an external (parental) email address than one from a student, as this will allow video calling.

Slots are booked on your behalf by students during their lessons. You will have the opportunity to ask questions and to review how the year has been for your child. Teachers will also share with you their updated grade predictions from the most recent assessments students have taken.

The exception to all this is A Level and Level 3 Maths, for which Mrs. Shaw will arrange appointments separately as she is unable to be present on the 17th.
