## Re: Fundraising Day - Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April

The School Council and the Sixth Form Committee will be hosting a fundraising event next Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April. This event will be hoping to raise money for humanitarian causes with all proceeds going directly to the Disasters Emergency Committee. This committee is working closely with the Red Cross to supply humanitarian aid to victims of conflict and they have launched a specific Ukraine appeal. On the day, a number of activities will be taking place that students will be invited to take part in. There will be a bake sale, an Easter egg raffle with numerous chocolate egg prizes and a large chocolate hamper to be won and a guessing the sweets (in a very large!) jar. These events will be taking place in the Sports Hall at break and lunch time. At the same time, staff will be hosting a second bake sale in the staffroom. Throughout the day, a dedicated team of sixth form students will be washing the cars of staff and fellow sixth form students. Baked goods will be at varying prices up to £1 and will be nut-free. Prices of Easter egg raffle tickets will be 30p/ticket or £1/ strip of 5 tickets, prizes will be drawn at the end of the day. The car wash for staff/student cars will be £5 for an external wash.

If any families would like to donate items for the Easter egg raffle or the bake sale, these will be gratefully received. Any baked items (homemade/purchased, sweet/savoury) and Easter eggs are welcome, all we ask is that items are nut-free and any containers that need returning are labelled with your child's name on them. Free-from bakes are most welcome as we have a number of students with specific diets (please label these to help us to know which ones are free-from). Please ask your child to bring any items to Miss Pickering in Marx (top floor classroom) and these will be looked after until the day.
