## Re Final arrangements for year 11 students

The exams are in sight, formal lessons will be finishing on the 10<sup>th</sup> May 2019 and students will enter a new phase of supervised study sessions from **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May**. With all this happening I wanted to make sure that everyone was aware of the final arrangements for this year.

The final exam before half term is English Literature on the morning of **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May** and we will be using the end of the school day as the point where year 11s go on study leave. Following the end of this exam all students will have some sports time, a humanities revision session and an end of year assembly will follow during period 6. Students will be free to be collected from school from **3.30pm** onwards.

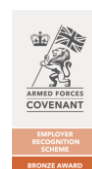

Students are still required to attend their revision sessions as outlined in the study programme as well as arriving promptly for their final exams. For any students who would like to remain in school during these final few weeks we will be organising a supervised study area within the school for year 11 students to base themselves in. On **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June**, senior members of staff will collect Chromebooks from the students during period 6 (the Chemistry study session). I would like to remind parents and students of their responsibility to ensure that the Chromebook is returned in good condition. As per the agreement that was signed "*damage deemed likely to have been caused intentionally or through misuse... will result in the cost of repair being forwarded to the parent.*" This is essential so that the Chromebooks can continue to be used by other year 11s in the future.
