Dear Parents and Carers

As I am sure you are aware, your son/daughter has purchased a ticket for our Year 11 visit to watch a live performance of Macbeth in Stratford Upon Avon.

We will be leaving school at 4pm on Thursday 7th September, and students are expected to remain in school between the end of the day and our departure time.

We will be returning quite late- the coach company estimates 12:00 or later depending on the end of the performance time. I will encourage students to contact you once we are on the coach, and again when we are close to the school for pick up.

We will be eating upon our arrival at the theatre, or on the coach, so students must all bring packed meals which are appropriate- I suggest sandwiches or similar plus a drink.

Students are expected to wear school uniform but I would suggest a change of shoes as we will be walking from the coach parking to the theatre and back.

The forecast is for dry weather, but again, as it will be late at night, they may want a jumper or a coat for the late return.

As always, students may use their phones to listen to music on the coach, but must make sure they have headphones, and remember that they are responsible for the appropriate use of their phones as well as their security.

The school nurse will be preparing a list of students with medical concerns, but please check that your son or daughter has all necessary medications with them, and if relevant, travel sickness medicine as well. If anything has changed regarding your son/daughter's medical details, please make Mrs Rachael Arthur (medical@sirthomasfremantle.org) or myself (rebecca.stone@sirthomasfremantle.org) aware as soon as possible.

I have briefed Year 11 in English today but please do inform them of the timings and expectations I have mentioned here.
