Dear Parents & Carers,

I would like to congratulate students on how well they have settled so far in the mock exams. It has been pleasing to see the impressive levels of behaviour and effort across all the exams.

You may recall I mentioned the Y11 Leavers Prom at the revision evening earlier in the month, and I am excited to share more details with you.

The prom will be held on **Thursday 27th June at Abbey Hill Golf Centre from 7pm-11pm**. Tickets are £38 and include a welcome drink on arrival, buffet food and DJ.

To secure a place at the prom for your child, please pay a deposit (non-refundable) of **£20 via ParentPay by 19th December**, with the remaining balance due in the Spring. We may be able to offer financial assistance in certain circumstances, so please email verity.ellis@sirthomasfremantle.org to discuss this if required.

Our aim is for the prom to be a celebration of the successes of the year group, and a reward for their hard work, and as such we will be monitoring the following aspects across the year to ensure students are making the most of this important year.

We will be looking at the following areas:

- Attendance – at 95% or above
- Punctuality - whether students have been placed on punctuality report
- Behaviour - 90% positive points or above, or whether students are placed on report
- Homework – no more than 3 homework detentions in a half term

It is our intention to discount the cost of tickets for students who have exceptional records this year.

All students began 1st November on Green in all of these areas, and we will be considering these areas from then. If students are not meeting the standards in any of these areas, they will have a discussion with their tutor and be placed on Amber. If an improvement is seen, they will then return to Green. If no improvement is seen, students will move to Red.

At Easter, discussions will take place with students as to whether they have met the criteria for attending the leavers prom. Students who are in Red for two or more areas, will not be permitted to attend. If they are in Amber, decisions will be taken on a case-by-case basis. Please note that the deposit is non-refundable, even in the case that students are not permitted to attend.

I am extremely proud of the way students have conducted themselves so far during the mock exams, and very excited to be planning a fantastic leavers prom for them. I look forward to seeing as many students there as possible and celebrating all their hard work.
