Dear Parents & Carers,

We are fast approaching the final set of mock exams in preparation for the formal examinations in the Summer Term. Please find the mock exam timetable attached.

I would like to take this opportunity to reiterate the importance of students attending these mock exams and arriving with plenty of time to prepare ahead of the scheduled start time.

It is important to understand that with all formal examinations the dates and times are set by the individual exam boards, therefore they are unable to be rescheduled or delayed. We host mock exams in a similar way, and students will be expected to attend every exam promptly at the specified time.

I would also like to remind students of the importance of arriving to their exams fully equipped. We can not guarantee there will be sufficient spare equipment available to borrow, and students are unable to borrow equipment from each another during an exam.

It is vital that each student has the correct equipment to enable them to access their examination.

Below is a suggested equipment list:

- Black biro(s)
- Pencil(s)
- Rubber
- Clear transparent ruler
- Highlighters
- Scientific Calculator (the lid must be left in their lockers)
- Compass
- Protractor

All equipment must be in a clear/transparent pencil case, or a clear bag - such as a sandwich bag. If you are unable to provide your child with the required equipment, please do let us know in advance of the mocks.

As with all previous mocks, students are familiar with the expectation that only water is allowed into the examination hall and this must be in a clear/transparent water bottle.

Students entering the examination hall must ensure that they are wearing correct uniform. As with previous mock exams, students are permitted to wear a plain black or navy jumper. Hoodies, coats and scarves are not permitted, in alignment with our uniform policy.

Any students who arrive wearing incorrect uniform will not be permitted to enter the examination hall.
