Thank you for your support with your son/daughter in their GCSE Music lessons. Non-Examined Assessment (NEA) is worth 60% of the overall GCSE grade. Pupils are expected to complete X2 GCSE compositions (Free Composition and Composition to a Brief) in controlled assessment conditions and X2 performances (solo and a group performance).

To help your child manage the work load there will be the following deadlines:

Friday 20th October: Solo Performance Recording completed (worth 15% overall GCSE grade)

**Tuesday 19th December:** Ensemble Performance Recording completed (worth 15% overall GCSE grade) & Free composition completed (worth 15% overall GCSE grade)

Friday 9th February: Brief Composition write up (worth 15% overall GCSE grade)

Wednesday 27th March: Final NEA coursework Deadline (worth 60% overall GCSE grade)

I will be speaking to the students individually to arrange suitable times to record their performances before the deadline. In addition the students will be performing in a Y11 concert at the end of this term. The concert provides an additional opportunity for students to record their performance pieces, and celebrate their performing skills! This will be open to an external audience. Revision materials
